

Batting available through Quilts by Kristy

**The batting sample squares are stapled in the order listed on the chart.*

<p>Hobbs Heirloom 80/20 (natural, bleached, and black)</p>	<p>Batting is 80% cotton and 20% polyester fiber; the cotton gives it a nice drape and the polyester gives the quilting just a bit of dimension.</p> <p>Bleached (white) is used for quilts pieced with very light or white fabric. Black is used backings and tops that are very dark. Natural works all other quilts.</p> <p>Mostly breathable and medium weight.</p> <p>Natural comes in 96" and 120" lengths. Bleached and black come in 108" lengths.</p>
<p>Quilter's Dream 100% Cotton Request Loft</p>	<p>Batting is 100% natural cotton.</p> <p>The Request loft is ultra-thin and is good for light summer quilts and quilts pieced with heavy backings.</p> <p>Most breathable.</p> <p>Comes in 90" length (larger sizes and/or bleached available for special order).</p>
<p>Quilter's Dream 100% Cotton Select Loft</p>	<p>Batting is 100% natural cotton.</p> <p>The Select loft is one step thicker and is good for quilts that want a bit heavier, drapey feel.</p> <p>Breathable.</p> <p>Comes in 90" length (larger sizes and/or bleached available for special order)</p>
<p>Hobbs Poly-Down</p>	<p>Batting is 100% polyester; it has a higher loft than cotton/blend batting, so this gives more "puff" or dimension to the quilting.</p> <p>Least breathable. Warmest. Lightweight.</p> <p>Comes in 108" length.</p>
<p>Hobbs Heirloom Wool</p>	<p>Batting is 100% wool; it has a loft similar to polyester, giving the quilting more dimension.</p> <p>Breathable. Lightweight. Resists creasing.</p> <p>Yellow in color; does not work well for light/white quilts.</p> <p>Comes in 108" length.</p>
